

AADO-HKSSH Conjoint Scientific Meeting was held on 19th March, 2023 at Orthopaedic Learning Centre, PWH. We have lectures in the morning on "Current Management of Upper Limb Trauma", and hands-on workshop in the afternoon about upper limb arthroscopic applications. Wrist arthroscopy equipment setup, various repair implants and suture management were demonstrated by experienced hand surgeons. Participants could practise and become more familiar with these new instruments and implants.
